



## WHITE WINES

### 1. Chenin Blanc, Cannonberg, Western Cape, South Africa, 2013

Crispy, zesty and full of fruit. From cool vineyards in the mountains north of Cape Town.

### 2. Sauvignon Blanc, Terre Des Olivettes, IGT Pays d'Oc, 2012

With a classic grassy nose, crisp acidity and rounded citrus flavours, this wine is a splendid aperitif and is excellent with salads and seafood.

### 3. Sauvignon Colombard, Aramis, Cotes de Gascogne, France, 2012

Pure, fresh, lime and lemon zest-scented Sauvignon Blanc Colombard blend. Intense fruit flavours in the attack precede a lingering citrus finish.

### 4. Pinot Grigio, Tre Fili, Veneto, Italy, 2012

A refined nose of pears and peaches is followed by a complex palate and a long nutty finish.

### 5. Picpoul de Pinet, Grand Vin du Languedoc, 2013

Crisp with floral and citrus fruit flavours. Vines grow near the famous Etang de Thau oyster beds.

## PROSECCO

### 9. Prosecco ORGANIC, La Jara, Treviso, Italy Frizzante NV

Made in Treviso in the North East of Italy, this is a delicious sparkling wine, full of refreshing green apples and elderflower. The perfect aperitif.

## RED WINES

### 10. Merlot, Terres des Olivettes, IGT Pays d'Oc, France, 2012

The favourite of Monsieur Glover! Soft with ripe fruits and a lovely plummy finish.

### 11. Cabernet Sauvignon, Cannonberg, Western Cape, South Africa, 2012

Another excellent example of the potential of the Cape's vineyards with notes of cherry, cassis and plum.

### 12. Corbieres, Lo Petit Fantet d'Hippolyte, Ollieux Romanis, France, 2012

'Lo Petit Fantet d'Hyppolite' is a blend of mainly Carignan with a splash of Grenache Noir and Syrah and is fermented with natural yeasts and no added sulphur. The label is designed by Pierre's young son, Hyppolite, who often accompanies his father into the vineyards. Notes of thyme, rosemary and black cherry with a hint of woody spice.

### 13. Merlot Malbec, Tour des Gendres, Bergerac, France, 2012

Strictly farmed according to organic and biodynamic principles by Luc de Conti who founded the estate in 1981. Soft with flavours of plums, red cherries and spices backed up by hints of vanilla and chocolate.

## ROSE WINE

### 14. Lo Bartas Organic Rose, VDP d'Oc, France, 2012

Made from cinsault & syrah, this rosé is totally fruit driven with soft red berries and spicy characters finishing with well-balanced acidity. Delicious!
